

## Descendants of Pvt. Jeduthan Waite and Naomi Sterling

1. Pvt. Jeduthan<sup>1</sup> Waite<sup>1</sup>, born<sup>2, 3</sup> 7 Jun 1754 in Brookfield, Worcester, Ma; died<sup>4, 5, 6</sup> 2 Apr 1829 in Waitsfield, Washington, VT; buried<sup>7</sup> in Irasville Cemetery, Irasville, Washington, VT, son of John Waite and Eunice Morse. He married<sup>8</sup> on 10 Jan 1790 in Kingston, now Granville, Addison, VT Naomi Sterling<sup>9</sup>, born<sup>10, 11</sup> 1 Nov 1770 in Lyme, New London, CT; died<sup>12</sup> aft 4 Aug 1853 in ps. Loraine or Corlish County, OH, daughter of Nathan Sterling and Elizabeth Morgan. 1790 US Census for Chittenden County, Waitsfield Town lists Jeduthan Wait 1 male over 16; 1 female over 16. (CEN1790) 1795 rated for a poll tax at Waitsfield, VT. (HWV) Census<sup>13</sup> Warren Division, Washington, VT (17 Sep 1850).

"Jeduthan and William Wait, the youngest of the seven brothers, served throughout the Revolution in Washington's Continental Line, and were together in the same company much of the time. About 1790, both moved to Waitsfield, Vermont, which had been founded in 1789 by their brother, General Benjamin, all three living there the rest of their lives." (VHSL)

### Revolutionary War Service Record of Jeduthan Waite

"STATE OF VERMONT, Jeduthan Waite of Waitsfield in the County of Washington the State of Vermont being duly sworn, doth declare, depose and say, that, on or about the 24th day of April AD 1775 he was duly enlisted into the service of the United States, for the term of eight months that he belonged to Captain Peter Harrod's Company, and Colonel Lemuel's Regiment, of the Massachusetts line and served therein, against the common enemy, as a Private. That at the expiration of said term in the month of December 1775 he again enlisted as a Private in Capt. Ira Danforth's Company of Col. Shepard's Regiment of the Massachusetts line for the term of one year and served therein until about the 30th day of [ ] 1777 and again enlisted in Capt. Harwood's Company of Col. Thomas Nixon's Regiment of the Massachusetts line for the term of three years and serving out [ ] term of time he again enlisted in same service for the term of duration of the war and belonged to Capt. William Toogood's Company of Colonel Thomas Nixon's Regiment of the Massachusetts line and continued this enlistment and served until honorably discharged by Gen. George Washington at Newburgh in the State of New York in the month of Jun. 1783 having faithfully by record the full period of my enlistment and he further says that he is [ ] a citizen of the United States and that by reasons of his reduced circumstances in life he is in need of subsistence from his country for support.

This is obviously the record for Naomi Wait (although I must confess I looked at it once and disregarded it anyway). Although the name is strange and the sex is wrong...Elizabeth 1 is the exact age for Elizabeth Wright, her daughter, and the fact that they are all called Wait is not particularly disconcerting...I've seen that error before...and these errors make sense in light of the fact that I've been unable to locate Alanzo Wright and family in any other census. It appears he may have died by this time. There is a large gap between Elizabeth and Nelson...keep in mind she may have had a second husband.

In September 1821, Jeduthan made the following declaration's concerning his Revolutionary War Service. "Served in Capt. Peter Harwood's Company and Col. Larned's Regiment of the Massachusetts line for eight months in 1775 in Capt. Danforth's Company and Col. Larned's and Shepard's Regiment during the year 1776 - in the spring of 1777 enlisted in Capt. Toogood's Company and Col. Nixon's Regiment of the Massachusetts line during the war and served therein until the end of the war in 1783 and was honorably discharged..."

From Naomi's statement dated 31 Aug. 1839 we learn that Jeduthan "entered into the service of the United States at the commencement of the war, and continued in the service under several enlistment's until the close of the war, that he was at the taking of Burgoyne and (she thinks) at the battle of Bunker's Hill, that the first eight months of his service he served under Colonel Larnad and Captain Harrod, that he resided at the time of his first enlistment in the service in the town of Braintree and Commonwealth of Massachusetts that he was a volunteer..."

From THE GENEALOGICAL DEPARTMENT, Source Records from the DAR Magazine, 1947-1950 I learned that Naomi's pension was transferred from Montpelier May 13, 1852 to Cleveland, Ohio Aug. 11, 1853. They refer to the pension number as 2,486. This information was not included in the pension record above and it may offer a valuable clue as to where Naomi ultimately and finally settled.

The Pension Record of Jeduthan Waite

26 Mch. 1818

William Waite of Waitsfield, Washington Co., Vermont deposed that he was acquainted with Jeduthan and in fact had served in all the same Companies and Regiments with the exception of the last term of service.

26 Mch. 1818

Jeduthan signed a Power of Attorney granting George Rich of Montpelier authority over his pension and granting decision making ability for same.

11 May 1818

Jeduthan - Certificate of Pension issued. Transcribed on the Roll of Vermont at the rate of 80 Dollars per month, to commence on the 15th of Apr. 1818.

12 Feb. 1819

Letter authorizing Jeduthan's land warrant to be delivered to Samuel E. Crafts, a member of Congress.

25 Feb. 1819

Jeduthan - Land Warrant issued (signed Horace C. Crafts).

Sept. 1821

Jeduthan provided a schedule of his net worth (the value of his property was \$32.62) and gave the following statement. "I am by occupation a farmer and can labor some - my wife Naomi is fifty three years of age and is feeble - my daughter Anna of the age of 30 years, never walked or spoke and is unable to do anything for her support and is wholly dependent on me - my son Levi of the age of 14 is able to support himself and nothing more - my son Morgan of the age of 12 years, is feeble and not able to support himself - I have no other means of support except from my country."

7 Jan. 1822

Letter sent by Samuel C. Crafts along with Jeduthan's declaration for the purpose of continuing him on the Pension Roll. It was Crafts' understanding that he had not been stricken

under the Act of May 1820 for having possessed too much property. "...and from his declaration, the truth of which I have no reason to doubt, it would seem that he is poor enough to entitle him to a pension."

22 Jul. 1839

Joel Rice of Granville Vermont deposed that Jeduthan married Naomi Sterling of Granville soon after he arrived in town about 50 years prior. He further deposed that he did not attend the wedding but that Daniel King Esq. Would have performed the ceremony as he was the only magistrate in town and there was no minister there. Jeduthan and Naomi moved to Waitsfield shortly after their marriage. He was acquainted with Jeduthan until his death about 10 years prior.

31 Aug. 1839

Naomi, a resident of Warren, aged 67, deposed to apply for a widow's pension under the Act of 7 Jul. 1838. She declared that she was married to Jeduthan 10 Jan. 1790 at Kingston now Granville in Addison Co. Vermont by Daniel King Esq., JP. That Jeduthan died 8 Apr. 1829.

3 Sept. 1839

William Waite of Warren in Washington Co. Aged 42 deposed that he was the son of Jeduthan and Naomi formerly of Waitsfield and that his mother had never remarried.

4 Sept. 1839

William M. Pingry of Waitsfield, Town Clerk, provided an extract of the family of Jeduthan & Naomi Wait from the town records. Viz. Anna born 10 Jul. 1791; Eunice born 6 Jun. 1793 died 5 Sept. 1799; Eli born 6 Feb. 1795; William born 3 Apr. 1797; Nathaniel born 16 Sept. 1799; Nathan born 28 Jul. 1801; Susanna born 11 Aug. 1803; Levi born 12 Aug. 1805. He further stated that he examined the records on 11 Feb. 1840 of Granville, Vermont from the organization of the town to the present date and could find no record of the marriage of Jeduthan and Naomi. This appears to have been the date that Naomi's certificate of Pension under the Act of 7 Jul. 1838 was issued.

9 Aug. 1843

Naomi, age 72, a resident of Warren Washington Co., Vermont appeared before the J.P. to make her Declaration in order to obtain benefits under the Act of 3 Mch. 1843.

5 Dec. 1843

Certificate of Pension issued to Naomi Wait under the Act of 3 Mch. 1843.

5 Jun. 1848

Naomi was added to the Pension Roll at the rate of \$96.00 per year. Page 384 Vol. 3. There is a note referencing Madison Wisconsin but no date as to the transfer. Other notes on the page seem to reference the transfer from Wisconsin to Ohio occurred in Jul. and Aug. of 1853.

1 Jul. 1848

It appears that payment of Naomi's pension under the Act of 2 Feb. 1848 was to be paid at Montpelier.

4 Jul. 1848. Naomi, age 76, appeared before the J.P. in Washington Co. For the purpose of obtaining the benefits of the Pension Act of Congress of 2 Feb. 1848. She stated that she had been pensioned under the Acts of 7 Jul. 1838; 3 Mch. 1843 and 17 Jun. 1844 at the rate of \$80.00 per year paid by the Pension Agency at Montpelier.

16 Sept. 1848

Naomi's Declaration for the benefit of the provision of the Act of Congress 2 Feb. 1848 was sent for issuance of her Certificate.

24 Oct. 1848

Letter stating that the Declaration of Naomi was sent back on 18 Sept. 1848 and requesting that her Certificate be issued.

19 Dec. 1848

Naomi's Certificate of Pension issued and recorded on Roll of Pensioners under the Act February 2, 1848, Page 103 Vol. 3.

7 Apr. 1852

Naomi appeared before the J.P. at Dane Co. Wisconsin and presented her Widow's Pension Certificate granted 19 Dec. 1848. She was requesting a transfer of her pension to the Pension Roll of Wisconsin and stated that she was still the widow of Jeduthan and resided in the state of Wisconsin for four months and furthermore that she had resided at Warren Vermont prior to her move to Wisconsin.

15 Apr. 1852 Letter from Madison, Wisconsin along with Naomi's affidavit that she had removed from Vermont to Wisconsin and requesting that she be paid there. Additionally, she was requesting that she receive \$96.00 per year as other widows in Vermont were receiving rather than \$80.00 per year.

6 May 1852

Letter from Pension Agency Office at Montpelier verified that Naomi had received her pension to the 4th of March 1851 under the Act of 2 Feb. 1848.

31 May 1852

Letter from Madison WI along with Naomi's Certificate was mailed in order to have her annual rate increased to \$96.00 per year and to have a new Certificate issued.

21 Jun. 1853

Letter from LaPorte Loraine County, Ohio confirms that Naomi was inscribed at the rate of \$96.00 per year under the Act of 2 Feb. 1848. "Her said pension was transferred from the Roll of Montpelier Vermont to that of Milwaukee Wisconsin May 13th 1852 to take effect from and after the 4th March 1851. Her pension has been paid up to the 4th of March 1853. She has since removed to live with her son in [Corlish]2 Loraine County Ohio where she expects to spend the remainder of her days and is desirous that her pension be transferred for payment to the office for Paying Pensions in this County."

4 Jul. 1853 Naomi J.P. at Loraine Co. Ohio and requested that her pension be transferred to the Ohio Pension Roll. She had removed to Ohio to spend her remaining days with her son Levi.

4 Aug. 1853

Letter from Pension Agency Office at Milwaukee verified that Naomi had received her pension to the 4th of March 1853 under the Act of 2 Feb. 1848.

5 May 1905

Bertha E. Savage of Waitsfield, Vermont requested a copy of the pension record.<sup>14</sup> (W.4842)

Jeduthan's ear mark for cattle and sheep as recorded in the Waitsfield town records was "a half crop the underside of each ear" and was recorded 9 Sep 1805. This mark was later transferred to Aaron Palmer in 1832. (WVR)

Washington County; Jeduthan Wait; Private; Annual Allowance \$96.00; Sums Received \$1,056.28; Massachusetts Continental Line; Placed on pension roll 11 May 1818; Commencement of pension 1 Apr 1818; Age 74; Died 1 Apr 1829. (VP)

Jeduthan Wait's home at Waitsfield was located on a hill south west of the village square. The road from Jeduthan's house was laid out directly down the hill with a "trustle bridge" across the brook and on to the village. Jeduthan Wait's farm home is one of the oldest in Waitsfield, as he occupied it as early as 1790 even though he didn't acquire title until 1807. Jeduthan's farm is now the location of "The Wait Farm Motor Inn", a motel on the east side of route 100 just south of village toward Irasville. A few hundred yards further south, just beyond a small modern shopping center, is the Irasville Cemetery where Jeduthan's grave is marked by a small stone indicating his participation in Nixon's regiment and the revolution. His brother William's grave is adjacent in the next row. A Memorial erected at Village Cemetery in Waitsfield, Vermont names some 31 Soldiers of the American Revolution who lie buried within the borders of Waitsfield. Jeduthan Wait's name is among them. (HALLSIS)

Naomi may have been residing with her son William's family at the time of the 1840 census. (USC1840) Naomi was listed as a member of the Waitsfield Congregational Church of Christ 18 Feb 1818. She was admitted 31 Jul 1814. "Naomi (Sterling) Wait apparently moved to Illinois according to Waitsfield Church records dismissing her to that state." (HALLSIS) By April 1852 she was in Dane Co., Wisconsin residing with her son Levi. In 1853 they removed from Dane Co. to LaPorte, Lorain, OH. (W.4842)

4. Eli<sup>2</sup> Waite<sup>30</sup> (Jeduthan<sup>1</sup>), born<sup>31, 32, 33, 34</sup> 6 Feb 1795 in Waitsfield, Washington, VT; died<sup>35</sup> 1880 in Hinsdale, Cattaraugus, NY. He married<sup>36, 37</sup> in 1823 in Cuba, Allegheny, NY Hannah Sherlock<sup>38, 39</sup>, born<sup>40</sup> 1806 in New York; died 1878 in Hinsdale, Cattaraugus, NY, daughter of Thomas Sherlock and Esther Beers. NY State Census Hinsdale-Ischua 1835 - Eli Waite 16:235...also listed were Sherlock Henry T. 16:233 and Sherlock Stephen 16:234 USC1850 - US Census 1850 Rice, Cattaraugus, NY; 148/148 Rice Cattaraugus NY pg187<sup>41</sup> According to The History of Waitsfield, VT; Eli removed at a young age to Hinsdale, Cattaraugus, NY. It was said by a brother that he never married. From the census record quoted here, this appears not to have been the case. "The 1875 local census for Hinsdale (LDS film 0584492) shows: Eli Wait 81M Farmer born in Vermont Hannah Wait 68F Wife N.Y. (Hannah Sherlock)" (HALLSIS)

"At the age of 19, in 1814, Eli Wait served in Corning's detachment of the Vermont Volunteer Militia and in Capt. John Campbell's Company of Peck's 4th Regiment. He was called up to march to Burlington in April and the company was also called to fight at the Battle of Plattsburgh in September of 1814. His War of 1812 service was from 22 Apr 1814 to 25 Apr 1814 and 7 Sep 1814 to 6 Oct 1814. His Pension Certificate is number 24128. In the 1870's, Eli received a Bounty Land Warrant #22,072-160-55 and an eight dollar per month pension under pension certificate 24,128. I have received and reviewed Eli's pension file. Eli's agent for his pension application was located in Portville which apparently served as the county seat in those days." (HALLSIS)

"Governor Chittenden of Vermont had issued a patriotic address at the beginning of the invasion, calling upon the militia of his state to hasten to the aid of their brethren across the lake. It had been heartily responded to, and at the close of the memorable day of the battle not less than 2500 Green mountain boys were on the Saranac under Major General Strong. The militia of Washington and Warren Counties were also streaming toward Plattsburgh at the call of General Mooers (Private Eli Wait among them) and reinforcements of regulars were on their way." (HALLSIS)

"On 15 Nov 1815, Eli Waite purchased Lot 5, Section 12 Township 12 Range 2 from the Holland Land Company (Ref. 493-0027). This was in Genesee County, New York." (HALLSIS)

"The Waits lived to the southeast of Hinsdale toward Portville on Haskell Creek on Jollytown road in a place known as Haskell Flats. The Sherlocks lived just across the road. Beniah Wyatt and the Barnes lived less than two miles further south in the northern portion of Portville Township." (HALLSIS)

Alma's will was very interesting. She left a bed to Harvey Morgan who as we know was not her son and named her brother as executor. We know that William was dead by this time however it also appears that all of her other stepchildren were dead as well or possibly had moved out of the area since no grandchildren were mentioned. In William Allen's case for instance, he did not die until 1907 so he probably had moved from the area. Of course all three of these children could have died at a young age.

The will of Luana (Carroll) Waite was dated 15 December 1893. The inventory was taken 18 Jul 1894 and presented by Pliny F. Carroll, Executor. It was proved 30 Aug 1895. The total value of the estate was \$388.73.

"I Luana C. Waite of Waitsfield in the County of Washington and State of Vermont being of sound mind and memory have thought it best and do therefor make, ordain publish and declare this my last will and testament.

It is my will that all my just debts (if any) and charges of my funeral be paid and discharged by my executor hereinafter named and appointed out of my estate as soon as conveniently may be after my decease and I leave the charges of my funeral to the direction of my said executor.

I give devise and dispose of all my estate both real and personal, save what shall be necessary for the payment of my just debts and funeral charges, in the following manner.

I began searching for the farm where Nathan Waite settled when he first arrived in the Minnesota Territory. His farm was next to Abijah and Laura's in Jordan Township, Fillmore County. When finding it - it was the former home of my best friend in high school. We were both farm girls and I stayed over night at her home many times. A small deserted cemetery is on this land and I believe this was because his grandson John Baker was first buried on his property, but have no proof. The area was never designated a cemetery but had about 20 graves at one time. Nathan sold 1 acre to the school district for \$1.00 and in the handwritten deed he stated that the school would be built on a quarter of it and the remainder would be the cemetery. The children played among the stones. The wife, (a member of my family tree), of a 90 yr old gentleman who still lives about 2 miles from this, attended that school. He remembers it very well. As the road was widened, many times over the years, it has taken much of the cemetery and some say, many of the old burial remains. It was named Solom by a traveling minister in the 1870's. (MYRNA)
