

Descendants of Joseph Waite and Margaret Ann Ward

1. **Joseph¹ Waite**, born¹ 12 Feb 1828 in Barton-upon-Humber, Lincolnshire, England; died² in Barton-upon-Humber, Lincolnshire, England. He married **Margaret Ann Ward**.

Children of Joseph Waite and Margaret Ann Ward were as follows:

- 2 i **Frederick² Waite**. He married **Sophia (---)**. "Frederick may possibly have come out to Canada sometime after 1886 where he went to Toronto to work for Massey Ferguson." (DEW)
- 3 ii **Alexander² Waite**.
- 4 iii **Charles² Waite**, died³; killed with a saw.
- + 5 iv **John Edward² Waite**, born⁴ 1860 in Barton-upon-Humber, Lincolnshire, England; died⁵ 1 Aug 1945 in Forester's Falls, Ontario, Canada; buried⁶ in Gordon Cemetery. He married **Laura Caroline Akester**.
- + 6 v **Emma Elizabeth² Waite**. She married **Wilson Windle**.
- 7 vi **Joseph² Waite**, died⁷ in drowned at the Battle of Jutland.

5. **John Edward² Waite** (Joseph¹), born⁸ 1860 in Barton-upon-Humber, Lincolnshire, England; died⁹ 1 Aug 1945 in Forester's Falls, Ontario, Canada; buried¹⁰ in Gordon Cemetery. He married¹¹ on 25 Dec 1879 in Barton-upon-Humber, Lincolnshire, England **Laura Caroline Akester**, born¹² 1860; died¹³ 1933.

"John E. and Laura, along with his sister and brother-in-law, Emily Elizabeth and Wilson Windle, set bound for Canada from Liverpool, England, aboard the Steam Ship Sarmation on August 27, 1886, and disembarked in Quebec City on September 6. They made their way to Pembroke, Ontario, where the two men formed a partnership with a man named Hollinger and started the first brick yard in the Ottawa Valley. The operation was called the Windle Waite and Hollinger Brick Yard.

Shortly after the death of his son, John E. dissolved his association with Windle and Hollinger and relocated a new brick yard at Port du Fort on the Ottawa side of the Ottawa River. When these clay deposits gave out, he located for a third time at Foresters Falls and for a few years as many as 12 men worked at

the yard and at times as many as a dozen teams of horses with wagons would be lined up waiting to be loaded with brick or tile. Apparently John E. was trained in the art of boxing and a story was often repeated that one of his young workmen, who held a grudge, told his sixty year old boss "that he'd surely hang a beating on him he was only 25 years younger". The old JEW told his antagonist that his nose had yet to be hit and challenged him to be the first. The workman took a wild swing only to have his fist knocked away setting himself up for a good punch which ended the brawl much to the amusement of the other hired hands. Most of the homes built within a forty mile radius of Foresters Falls were constructed with Waite brick, each bearing the initials JEW." (DEW)
