

# Descendants of Richard Waite and Mary [Barnard]

1. Richard<sup>1</sup> Waite<sup>1, 2, 3</sup>, born<sup>4, 5</sup> 1608 in Wethersfield, Essex, England; died<sup>6, 7, 8</sup> 16 Jan 1668/69 in Watertown, Middlesex, MA. He married<sup>9</sup> in 1637 in Watertown, Middlesex, MA Mary [Barnard]<sup>10, 11, 12</sup>, born<sup>13, 14</sup> 1606 in England; died<sup>15, 16, 17</sup> 21 Jan 1678/79 in Watertown, Middlesex, MA.

Richard came to America in 1630 and was one of the original settlers of Watertown. He was probably a cousin of Thomas of Portsmouth RI. More than likely he was a cooper since he was paid one shilling sixpence in 1651 for "hooping the powder". Richard became a proprietor of Watertown in 1637. Richard was about 60 when he died. (SES)

Among the planters of Watertown, MA, was Richard Waite, who came from England, and in 1637 became a proprietor by purchasing all the lands and rights of one of the original grantees of the town. Of his three sons, John, Thomas, and Joseph, the descendants of the former removed to Farmington, MA, Joseph removed to Marlboro, MA, and Thomas remained in Watertown, where he acquired considerable property. Came to America circa 1630 and settled at Watertown where he received grants of land.

Received from Barbara T. Petty via Internet August 1998: "Richard Waite is said to have arrived in 1630 with the Winthrop Fleet and was one of the first settlers of Watertown where he received grants of land, in Volume 1 of The Abridged Compendium by Frederick Virkus. The Compendium is not, however, considered a most reliable resource. It goes on to state that he was a commissary in the Pequot War, an early war fought against the Pequot Indians in Connecticut, and was a special commissary to the Narragansetts in 1664, but this has not been independently verified by this compiler." [Note - this service may belong to Richard Waite of Boston]

Since there was another Richard Waite, a tailor of Boston, who held some positions of responsibility in the early history of the Massachusetts Bay Colony, and who was contemporaneous with our Richard Waite of Watertown, and has sometimes been confused with this man, it would need further research to confirm this statement. In fact in most instances that have been discovered so far, events surrounding the other Richard Waite of Boston seem to be attributed in error to our ancestor by some researchers.

Administration was granted to his widow Mary, February 16, following, on request of her 3 sons John, Thomas, and Joseph. Administration on the widow's estate was then granted to eldest son

"From John, descended John Wait who moved from Mason, NH to Andover, VT about 1795, locating in that portion of the town which later became Weston, VT." (HLV) I have a typescript of this line. However the author of the typescript believes that the line descends from Samuel of Boston. Although I suspect that the line does belong here, HLV offers no reason for their supposition, while the author of the typescript made a stab, albeit a weak one, at why the line descends from SOB. For this reason, the line is currently with SOB until I can prove otherwise. The children of the John of Weston, VT were John, Amos, Daniel, James, Sumner, Betsey, Sally and Lucinda. Sumner was b. 1807 at Weston and was a blacksmith. There is a list of his children in the typescript and Waters is not listed.

Although many sources state and re-state the information as given here, I am concerned about the twenty year age range between the five children in this family...could there be two families combined here? More work needs to be done.

According to History of the town of Waitsfield, VT he sold land in Weston 1715 and removed soon to Sudbury, Mass., where he remained until 1743, when he went to Worcester, MA; constable in Sudbury 1735. Served as a soldier in Queen Anne's War of 1702. (HALLSIS)

SES believes that Sarah may have been Sarah Warren, the daughter of Capt. John & Michal (Jennison) Warren. (See FGS) Widow of Joseph Stone. "My own feeling for Sarah is that there is a good case to be made for calling her Sarah Warren, the daughter of John Warren & Michal (Jennison) Bloys/Bloise. As noted, said Sarah was not named in her father's will and that is the one bad apple in the barrel. However, no record has been found of the early death of Sarah Warren & no record has been found of a marriage which would fit, other than the marriage of a Sarah to Joseph Stone 1693 in Watertown, Middlesex, MA.... Sarah had 1st child 1693, last known child Apr 1711, an 18 year period. Assuming age 40 in 1711, we might estimate a year of birth at 1671 for Sarah. This coincides very well with the daughter of John and Michal Warren, b. 25 Jan 1670/1. It is interesting to note that the Stone & Warren immigrant ancestors came from the same parish in England. Robert Charles Anderson's Great Migration Begins, Vol. 1 [Boston 1995] pp 677/8: 'When the Bishop's Visitation of 1629 in the Archdeaconry of Sudbury reached Nayland, five men were presented for refusing to kneel at communion: John Warren, John Firmyn, Christopher Scarlett, John Kent, and Gregory Stone...John Warren came to Watertown in 1630 and Gregory Stone came in 1635.'... As we have learned in previous correspondence with Bill Waite, his late father had somehow come to the conclusion that the Sarah we are concerned with was the daughter of John Warren. He may have found some clues that have so far eluded us and we may never find proof positive, but until someone has a better solution, I [SES] am going with the John Warren line." See record for Sarah Warren.

Prentices and Hatches. Between 1765 and 1780, there were sixty-two families settled in to stay."<sup>288</sup>

"The First Minutes of The Town March ye 11, 1766 Then at a Meeting held on the above mentioned day.

1. Did vote Timothy Delano Moderator to Govern ye meeting.
2. Voted Jason Wait Junr to be the Town Clerk.
3. Voted Jason Wait to be the First Selectman.
4. Voted Timothy Delano to be the Second Selectman.
5. Voted Joseph Warner to be the Third Selectman.
6. Voted Isaac Cady to be the Constable.
7. Voted that the Annually meeting shall be held at the house of Timothy Delanos till the town shall appoint some other place. The town's first historian was Reverend Seth S. Arnold between 1815 and 1833."<sup>289</sup>

"Maj. Jason Wait came from Grafton, Mass. to this place in the early part of its settlement; and was a brother of Doct. Wait, who was killed in the battle of Bunker's Hill. He married Miss Axtell, of Grafton, by whom he had one son and one daughter. [Note: I have not checked the Grafton VRs for record of this marriage, or birth of his children.] His father came with him, and died 1784 in the 82d year of his age. [Note: Jason Wait(e), brother of Gershom Wait(e) and probably father of the Jason Wait mentioned here was born in Marlborough, Mass. on 23 Nov 1702, so he would've been 82 years old in 1784; one of his sons, William Wait(e) was baptized in Grafton, on 23 Apr 1739. Maj. W. went forth into the military service of his country; was promoted to the rank of a captain, by Col. Wait, of Claremont, and afterwards to that of major. He was taken by the enemy; and at the capture of Burgoyne, he was retaken. He died in Westmoreland sometime since the close of the Revolutionary War."<sup>290</sup>
