1. Jonathan<sup>1</sup> Waite, born<sup>1, 2, 3, 4</sup> 26 Jul 1761; died<sup>5, 6, 7</sup> 27 Jul 1840 in Adams Co., OH; buried<sup>8</sup> in Drake Cemetery, Jefferson, Adams, OH. He married<sup>9</sup> on 26 Jan 1797 in Manchester, Adams, OH Naomi Collins, born<sup>10</sup> 18 May 1774; died<sup>11, 12</sup> 19 Oct 1864 in Adams Co., OH; buried<sup>13</sup> in Drake Cemetery, Jefferson, Adams, OH. Appears on the Voter's List for 1812 in Jefferson Twp. (ADSUE) A Jonathan Waite enlisted in 1777 as a private in Danvers, Essex, MA and eventually ended up in Adams Co., IL. (ADSUE)...wife aged 50-60. (USC1830)
